


Mesopelagic zone Twilight Zone

- Little light
- gets cold quickly with depth



These vertical migrations are known as **diel migrations**, because the journey has two parts: up at dusk and down at dawn.

Vertical migrators occur at all latitudes in all oceans. Different organisms migrate at different times to different depths. This migration allows organisms to remain at a constant level of low light at all times. Zooplankton migrate up at night to feed on phytoplankton, which always stay in the **euphotic** zone a
