
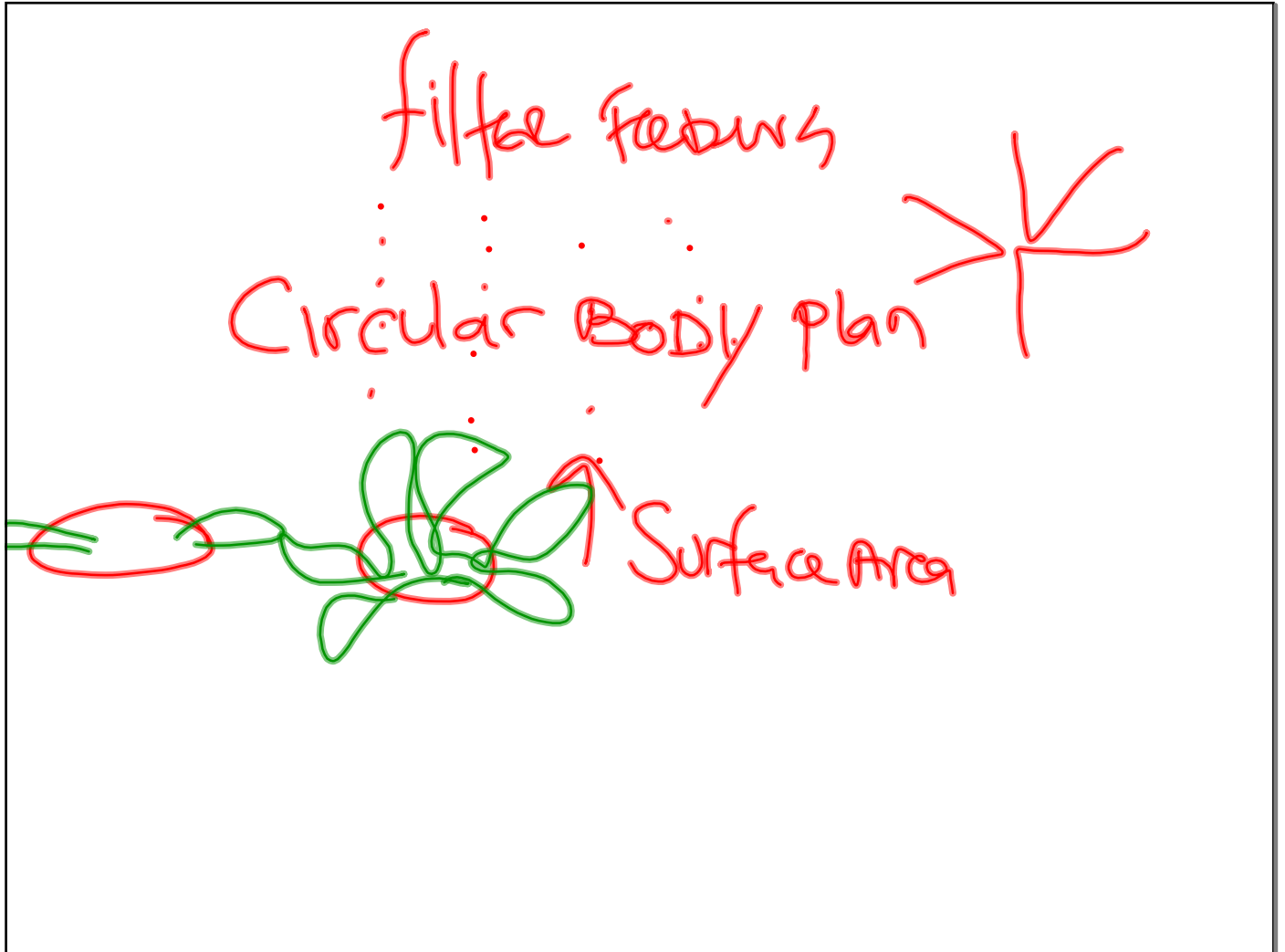
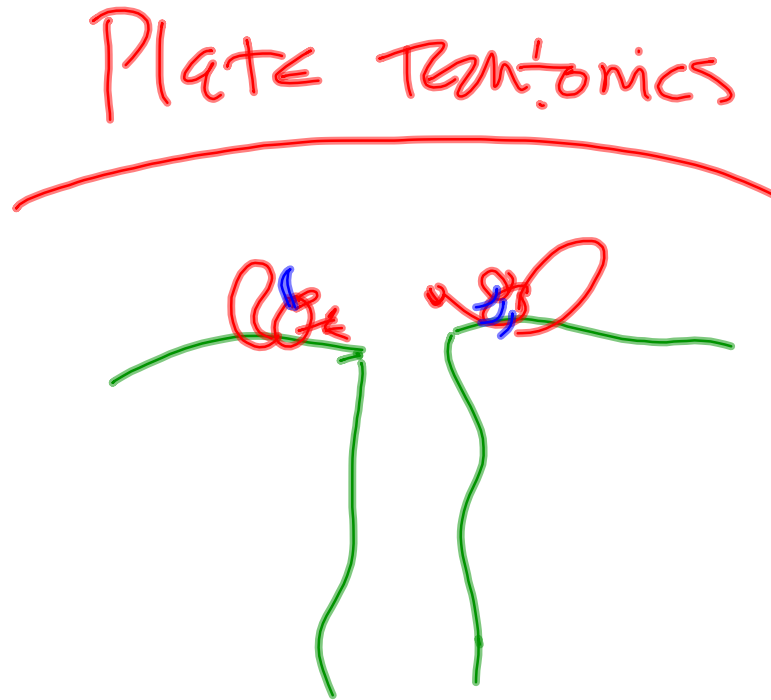
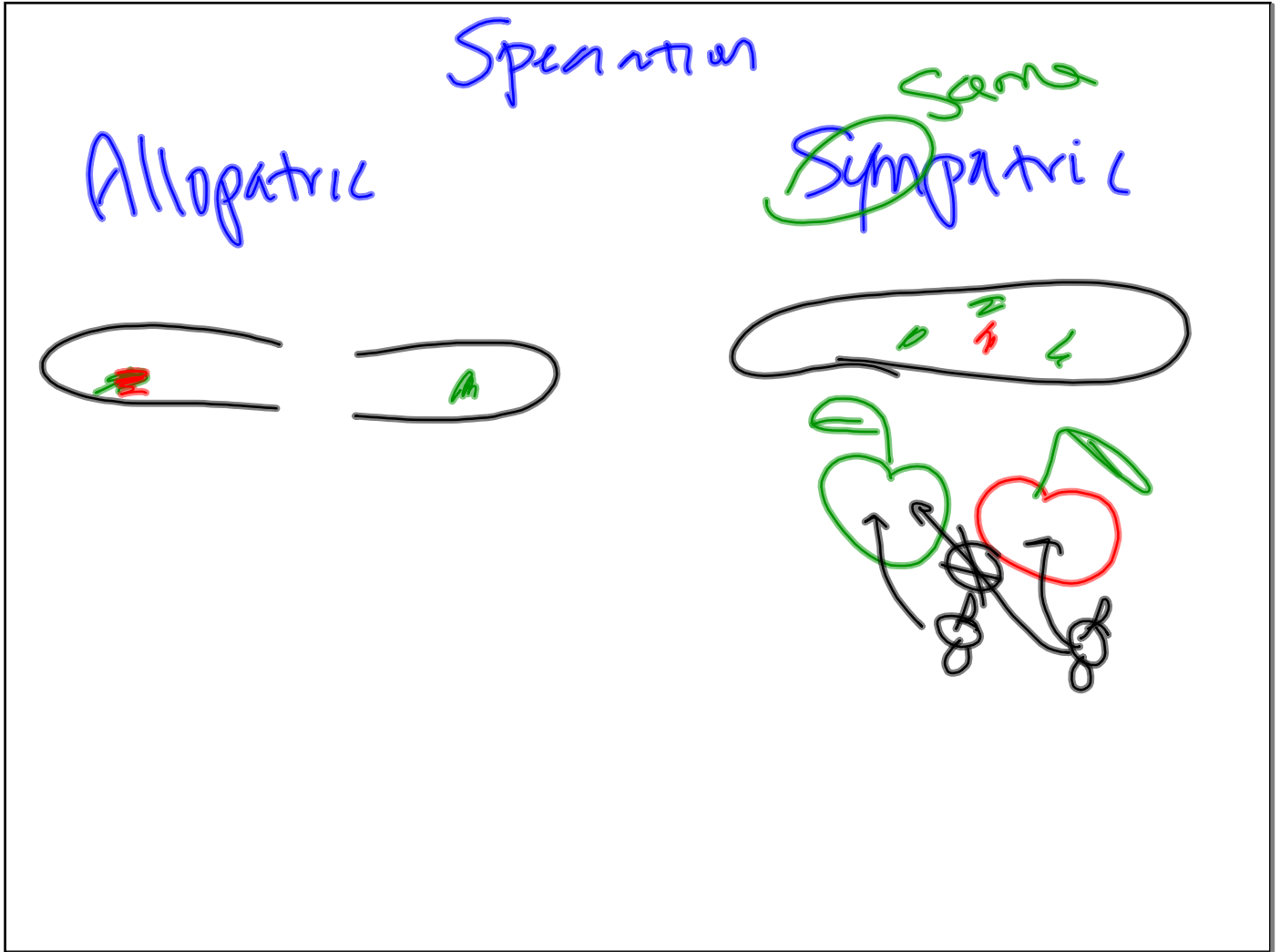


<p>Mesopelagic zone Twilight Zone</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Little light - gets cold quickly with depth 		<p>These vertical migrations are known as <u>diel migrations</u>, because the journey has two parts: up at dusk and down at dawn.</p> <p>Vertical migrators occur at all latitudes in all oceans. Different organisms migrate at different times to different depths. This migration allows organisms to remain at a constant level of low light at all times.</p> <p>Zooplankton migrate up at night to feed on phytoplankton, which always stay in the euphotic zone</p>	<p>Daily A/D Movement</p>
