Respiration

Gills

- a. General
 - gills are evaginations
 - typical of aquatic animals
 - blood is oxygenated by gills
 - oxygen delivered to tissues by blood
- b. Crustacean Gills
 - crustacean gills are usually associated with appendages
 - blood circulates through the gill and is oxygenated
- c. Book Lungs
 - present in many arachnid orders
 - similar to book gills of horseshoe crabs
 - oxygen transport from the lungs to the tissues is by blood
